**Mansfield University of Pennsylvania** is a member of the Pennsylvania State system of Higher Education (PASSHE). The system consists of fourteen (14) universities and educates more than 109,000 students. PASSHE is the largest higher education provider in Pennsylvania. **Mansfield University of Pennsylvania** is the second smallest university in the system with approximately 3,400 students from across the United States and countries world-wide.

As a small university, **Mansfield University of Pennsylvania** *combines the best qualities of a small liberal arts college with the resources of a comprehensive university.* We offer a *safe, personal and friendly* environment that includes all of what is usually found at much larger universities: a wide range of courses and majors, career-focused experiences, high-tech equipment, a wireless campus, and an impressive group of teaching professors.

**Mansfield University of Pennsylvania** is located in north-central Pennsylvania. Mansfield is nestled in a scenic mountainous region *four hours northwest of New York City and five hours north of Washington, DC.* The area is noted for its quality of life and numerous outdoor recreational opportunities. Outdoor activities include: hiking, biking and cross-country skiing. Due to our temperate climate, winters are usually mild and summers are typically cool.

As a *public liberal arts institution*, emphasis is placed on personal exploration and development of one's leadership potential. **Mansfield University of Pennsylvania** offers a non-credit based experience Leadership program (**Mountaineer Leadership Program**) which serves to develop skills in self-directed, team and change leadership. Certificates of various levels are earned....each focused on a specific leadership theme. Themes include those of the **Mansfield University of Pennsylvania** Creed of *Scholarship, Culture, Service and Character.*

*The Honors Program* at Mansfield University of Pennsylvania offers a dynamic learning environment that includes collaborative and individual research projects as well as field-based educational experiences. Upon graduation from the university, an Honors student will have the notation "*Graduate of the Honors Program*" recorded on his or her transcript.

International students attend an orientation designed to help the students become familiar with their new friends, faculty, staff of the university and environment. Students who score 550 (Written Format), 213 (Computer-Based Format), 80 (Internet-based Format) on the TOEFL exam, or a score of 6.5 or greater on the IELTS exam with no individual bands below 5.0 are eligible to begin university-level academic classes. *English as a Second Language (ESL) classes* are available to students with a score of 450 (Written Format), 133 (Computer-Based Format), or 45 (Internet-based Format) at *no additional cost.*

We *guarantee on-campus housing* for every student. We *match roommates carefully* and offer many of the conveniences of home. American and international students live together and learn cultural differences and similarities from one another.
